Participants are encouraged to bring their own food. Some food sharing groups will naturally form before and during the event. We will provide some space for you to cook, but you are encouraged to bring your own pots, and if you have them, camp stoves.

Dinner on Sunday night will be in the form of a camp-wide potluck. The theme is “primitive cook-off,” participants are encouraged to bring foods that they prepare with cast iron, clay pots, hot rock cooking, pit cooking, or that contain wild or garden grown foods. There will be classes that cover these cooking methods during the gathering. Don’t stress out about having something primitive to contribute. Any Good food is welcome (especially if it is organic).

Some dinners will be available by donation on Friday and Saturday nights, but these will be limited, so please don’t count on them. We will have coffee bar where coffee and tea can be acquired for a suggested donation.
